Mini Maker

Bounty

- 1 \$60 Bounty events use a \$20 bounty; the bounty for \$100 events is \$25.
- 2 All non-bounty payouts follow Standard Payout Table.
- 3 Bounty tournament and payout rules apply.
- 4 Bounty event participants are not eligible for chip bonuses, and cannot surrender chips.

Mulligan

- 1 Upon entry, each player will be issued a second reciept. This reciept will be marked by stamp or poker supervisor initials, the reciept will entitle the entrant to a second starting stack of chips to be used at their discretion
- 2 "Mulligan" stack is 15k chips.
- 3 "Mulligan" receipt must stay on table in full view or it may be void
- 4 Mulligan stack can be redeemed at any time between hands but must be redeemed by the end of the first break.
- 5 If not redeemed by the end of the first break, it hold no value and the bearer is not entitled to any further considerations.
- 6 Mulligan entrants are only eligible for chip bonus on their initial stack.
